STIPULATION AND ORDER OF CONSENT TO PUBLIC REPRIMAND

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In order to resolve the Formal Statement of Charges pending against him before the Nevada Commission on Judicial Discipline (the "Commission" or "NCJD"), the Respondent stipulates to the following pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 29:

1. Respondent admits he committed violations of the Revised Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct ("Code"), including Canon 1, Rule 1.1 requiring jurists to comply with the law, including the Code, and Rule 1.2 requiring a jurist to promote public confidence in the independence, integrity and impartiality of the judiciary; Canon 2, Rule 2.5(A) which mandates jurists perform judicial and administrative duties competently and

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diligently, Rule 2.7 requiring jurists to hear and decide matters assigned to them, except when disqualification is required, Rule 2.9 prohibiting ex parte communications, to the extent the communications are not protected by NRS 178.486 (requiring courts to give notice to district attorneys of discretionary bail), and Rule 2.11 requiring disqualification when the jurist's impartiality might be reasonably questioned. The Respondent further admits these violations occurred from in or about March 22, 2013 to March 25, 2013, by his performing a singular act, a combination of acts, or all of the following acts (collectively, the "acts"):

- A. Initiating or participating in a telephone conversation on or about March 25, 2013, with the deputy district attorney assigned to criminal case number 13CR1203H (the "case"), regarding the contested issue of the release of the defendant in the case from jail on his own recognizance ("O.R."), as well as regarding Respondent disqualifying himself and reasons for disqualification. During this conversation, the deputy district attorney told the Respondent he was opposed to such a release and wanted to prepare a motion in opposition.
- B. Making a ruling on the contested matter the same day by releasing the defendant in the case on O.R., before receiving the deputy district attorney's motion contesting such a release, and then making a decision to disqualify himself from the case without sufficient reason;
- C. Failing to recuse himself from the case pursuant to Nevada law and thereafter making a ruling on the contested issue of the defendant being released from jail on O.R.
- 2. Respondent admits to all the allegations brought against him in Counts One (1) through Six (6) of the Formal Statement of Charges, filed August 14, 2015, and paragraphs (1) and (1) (A) through (C) as set forth above.
- 3. Respondent agrees to waive his right to present his case contesting the allegations in the information set forth above in a formal hearing pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 18. Respondent further agrees that this Order takes effect immediately pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 29. The Commission accepts

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Respondent's waiver of said right and acknowledges and agrees to the immediate effect of this Order.

- Respondent agrees and acknowledges that this Stipulation and Order will be published on the Commission's website and filed with the Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court.
- 5. Respondent and the Commission hereby stipulate to Respondent's consent to public reprimand pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 29. Respondent stipulates to the following substantive provisions:
 - (a) He stipulates to a public reprimand by the Commission for violations of the Judicial Canons and Rules as set forth above in paragraphs (1) and (1) (A) through (C).
 - (b) He agrees the discipline of public reprimand is authorized by Article 6, Section 21(1) of the Nevada Constitution and Rule 29 of the Procedural Rules of the Commission.
 - (c) He agrees that the evidence available to the Commission would establish by clear and convincing proof that he violated the Revised Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct, including individual canon or combination of canons, Canon 1, Rules 1.1 and 1.2; Canon 2, Rules 2.5(A), 2.7, 2.9, to the extent the communications are not protected by NRS 178.486, and 2.11.
 - (d) The Respondent agrees to successfully complete a minimum of one (1) course at the National Judicial College in Reno within one (1) year of the Commission signing this Stipulation. He further agrees the course shall focus on fairness and ethics in the courtroom and knowledge and application of the law. The Respondent shall take this course at his own expense and provide the office of the Commission with proof of his attendance.

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- (e) The Respondent further agrees he shall study and familiarize himself with all Nevada statutes, rules of criminal procedure and local rules dealing with: ex parte communications, bail and O.R. releases and disqualification.
- 6. The Respondent understands and agrees that by accepting the terms of this Stipulation, he waives his right to appeal to the Nevada Supreme Court pursuant to Rule 3D of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent should be and hereby is publicly reprimanded for violating Canon 1, Rules 1.1 and 1.2; Canon 2, Rules 2.5(A), 2.7, 2.9, to the extent the communications are not protected by NRS 178.486, and 2.11 of the Revised Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that the Executive Director of the Judicial Discipline Commission take the necessary steps to file this document in the appropriate records and on the website of the Commission and with the Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court.
