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

### STIPULATION AND ORDER OF CONSENT TO PUBLIC REPRIMAND

In order to resolve the Formal Statement of Charges pending against her before the Nevada Commission on Judicial Discipline (the "Commission"), the Respondent stipulates to the following pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 29:

1. Respondent admits she committed violations of the Revised Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct ("Code"), including paragraph [1] of the Preamble which mandates an independent, fair, impartial and competent judiciary; Judicial Canon 1, Rule 1.1 (failure to comply with the law, including the Code) and Rule 1.2 (failure to promote public confidence in the judiciary); and Canon 2, Rule 2.2 (failure to uphold and apply the law), Rule 2.5(A) (failure to perform judicial and administrative duties competently and diligently), and Rule 2.9 (prohibiting ex parte communications by

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the Judge personally, or through her staff or the staff of the court clerk), by doing a singular act, a combination of acts, or all of the following acts:

- A. Issued, or caused to be issued, a complaint or bench warrant, or both, without factual or legal basis, against Strickly Truckin' Inc., a Utah Corporation, or Complainant Tracy Strickland, or both of them, for a motor carrier license violation pursuant to CFR 49 § 393.45 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations for brake tubing and hose;
- B. Without authority to investigate or prosecute misdemeanors, directed staff, on or about January 7, 2010, to incorrectly include Bill Strickland as the vehicle owner in Part B of the complaint;
- C. After the statute of limitations for such misdemeanors had run, issued, or caused to be issued, a complaint or bench warrant, or both, against Complainant Tracy Strickland for a motor carrier license violation pursuant to CFR 49 § 393.45 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations for brake tubing and hose;
- D. Without authority to investigate or prosecute misdemeanors, personally investigated, or ordered her staff or the staff of the court clerk to investigate, the name of the registered owner for Strickly Truckin' Inc., and then issued, or caused to be issued, a complaint or bench warrant, or both, against Strickly Truckin' Inc. or Complainant Tracy Strickland, or both of them, for a motor carrier license violation pursuant to CFR 49 § 393.45 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations for brake tubing and hose;
- E. Engaged in prohibited ex parte communications by personally, or through her staff or the staff of the court clerk, communicating, or considering communications, with Strickly Truckin' Inc., or Complainant Tracy Strickland, or both of them, outside the presence of the parties or their lawyers, concerning a pending matter, without consent of the parties or authorization of the law;

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- F. Engaged in plea negotiations contrary to law by personally, or through her staff or the staff of the court clerk, communicating with Strickly Truckin' Inc., or Complainant Tracy Strickland, or both of them, regarding possible resolution of the case;
- G. Abused her judicial authority by engaging in any or all, or any combination of, the acts listed above in paragraphs A through F (collectively referred to as "the acts").
- Respondent admits to all the allegations brought against her in Counts One (1)
  through six (6) of the Formal Statement of Charges, filed June 10, 2015, and
  paragraph (1) (A) through (G) as set forth above.
- 3. Respondent agrees to waive her right to present her case contesting the allegations in the information set forth above in a formal hearing pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 18. Respondent further agrees that this Order takes effect immediately pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 29. The Commission accepts Respondent's waiver of said right and acknowledges and agrees to the immediate effect of this Order.
- Respondent agrees and acknowledges that this Stipulation and Order will be published on the Commission's website and filed with the Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court.
- 5. Respondent and the Commission hereby stipulate to Respondent's consent to public reprimand pursuant to Commission Procedural Rule 29. Respondent stipulates to the following substantive provisions:
  - (a) She stipulates to a public reprimand by the Commission for violations of the Judicial Canons and Rules as set forth above in paragraph (1) (A) through (G).
  - (b) She agrees the discipline of public reprimand is authorized by Article 6, Section 21(1) of the Nevada Constitution and Rule 29 of the Procedural Rules of the Nevada Commission on Judicial Discipline.

- (c) She agrees that the evidence available to the Commission would establish by clear and convincing proof that she violated the Revised Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct, including paragraph [1] of the Preamble and an individual canon or combination of canons, including Judicial Canon 1, Rule 1.1and 1.2 and Canon 2, Rules 2.2, 2.5(A) and 2.9.
- (d) The Respondent agrees to successfully complete a minimum of two (2) courses at the National Judicial College in Reno within one (1) year of the Commission signing this Stipulation. She further agrees the courses shall focus on ethics and fairness in the courtroom and knowledge and application of the law. The Respondent shall take these courses at her own expense and provide the office of the Commission with proof of her attendance.
- (e) The Respondent shall study and familiarize herself with all Nevada statutes, rules of civil procedure and local rules dealing with: the issuance of warrants, jurisdiction over individuals and corporations, naming of parties in court actions, limitations on investigation of cases by judges and court personnel, prohibitions on ex parte communication by judges and court personnel and prohibitions on judges and court staff actively engaging in plea negotiations.
- The Respondent understands and agrees that by accepting the terms of this Stipulation, she waives her right to appeal to the Nevada Supreme Court pursuant to Rule 3D of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure.

#### ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent be and hereby is publicly reprimanded for violating paragraph [1] of the Preamble to the Revised Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct Judicial along with Canon 1, Rules 1.1 and 1.2 and Canon 2, Rules 2.2, 2.5(A) and 2.9.
