FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

In reference to the "Factual Allegations" set forth in the Formal Statement of Charges, the Respondent states as follows:

In reference to paragraph "A" of the Factual Allegations, Respondent admits to the truthfulness of the allegations set forth within that paragraph.

In reference to paragraph "B" of the Factual Allegations, Respondent denies that he "refused to perform" his duty as a search warrant judge on his rotations. Respondent in fact offered an alternative to allow an alternative municipal court judge to perform his "search warrant duties" during times other than 8:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m. and, further, contended that the alternative municipal court judges were authorized to do search warrant duty and, further, Respondent offered to pay out of his own salary for the authorized alternate municipal court judge to perform the search warrant duties. This offer, however, was not accepted.

In reference to paragraph "C" of the Factual Allegations, Respondent denies the allegations set forth therein.

In reference to paragraph "D" of the Factual Allegations, Respondent denies that he did not cooperate with the Chief Judge or other judges.

In reference to paragraph "E" of the Factual Allegations, it is accurate that the Respondent during the interview with the Commission's Investigator indicated he would continue to use an alternate judge for search warrant duties and it is further admitted that the Respondent indicated that he was willing in his Answer to Interrogatories to perform his search warrant duties if ordered by the Commission and, further, that Respondent would follow any Commission order.

In reference to paragraph "F" of the Factual Allegations, Respondent admits the allegations set forth in this paragraph with the exception being that he was "starting to have some concerns I might be missing calls as well."

In reference to paragraph "G" of the Factual Allegations, Respondent denies the allegations set forth in this paragraph and in fact submits to the Commission that there were medical reasons including his inability to "go back to sleep" after his sleep was interrupted by search warrant duties.

CHARGES OF MISCONDUCT 1 In reference to the "Charges of Misconduct" of the Formal Statement of Charges, Respondent 2 states as follows: 3 In answering those allegations set forth in Count One, the Respondent does deny that he violated 4 Rule 1.1, Rule 1.2, Rule 2.1, Rule 2.5(B), and Rule 2.7. 5 In answering those allegations set forth in Count Two, the Respondent does deny that he 6 violated Rule 1.1, Rule 1.2 and Rule 2.5(B). 7 AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES 8 In Count One, Complainant fails to specifically allege how Respondent's course of conduct 9 violated each Canon alleged. 10 In Count Two, Complainant fails to specifically allege how Respondent's course of conduct 11 12 violated each Canon alleged. **MITIGATING CIRCUMSTANCES** 13 In answering the Formal Statement of Charges, the Respondent does assert that there are 14 mitigating circumstances that are applicable to him including, but not limited to, the following: 15 an absence of a prior disciplinary record; 16 (1) 17 an absence of a dishonest or selfish motive; (2)full and free disclosure to the Judicial Ethics Panel and a cooperative attitude toward the 18 (3) 19 proceedings; the character and reputation of the Respondent; 20 (4) 21 physical inability of the Respondent; (5) remoteness of offense; and 22 (6)23 24 25 26
