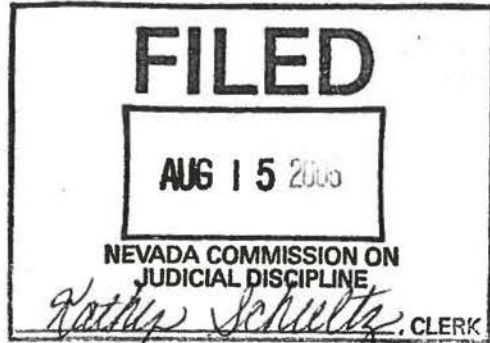

**ORDER AMENDING FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW  
AND IMPOSITION OF DISCIPLINE**

On August 4, 2005, the respondent filed a Motion to Amend and Correct the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Imposition of Discipline. He argues that the Commission's original disposition order should be amended at page 4, lines 8 and 9, to state the words "imposed in item (1) immediately above does not restrict the Respondent from providing services as a private or court appointed Special Master, Mediator or Arbitrator." On August 9, 2005, the Special Counsel filed a Notice of Non-Opposition to the Respondent's motion.

Good cause appearing, and pursuant to the unanimous vote of the commissioners who issued the original order, the Respondent's motion is granted. The full sentence beginning on page 4, line 7 and ending on page 4, line 9 of the Commission's July 19, 2005 written disposition entitled Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Imposition of Discipline, is amended to read as follows: "By way of clarification, the restriction imposed in item (1) immediately above does
