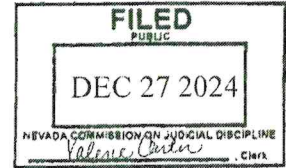

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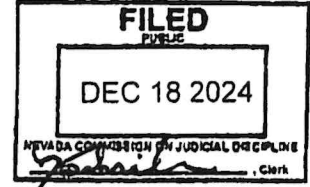

11 **ORDER RESCINDING AND REINSTATING SUSPENSION OF RESPONDENT FROM THE**
12 **EXERCISE OF JUDICIAL OFFICE WITHOUT SALARY**

14 On December 2, 2024, the Commission issued Respondent a Notice of Commission’s Intent to
15 Rescind and Reinstate Suspension of Respondent Without Salary (“Notice”), a copy of which is
16 attached hereto as Exhibit 1. In accordance with the Notice, NRS 1.4675(5) and Commission
17 Procedural Rule (“PRJDC”) 9.6(C)(ii), Respondent notified the Commission in writing on December 3,
18 2024, and requested the opportunity to appear at a public hearing to respond.

19 On December 13, 2024, a public hearing was held via Simultaneous Audiovisual Transmission
20 (“S.A.T.”) utilizing the Zoom virtual platform and was available to the public live via YouTube.
21 Pursuant to the Jury Verdict, which was filed in the United States District Court for the District of
22 Nevada on October 3, 2024 (Case No.: 2:24-cr-00155-JAD-DJA-1), the jury found Respondent guilty
23 of seven (7) felony counts under the laws of the United States as set forth in the Criminal Indictment
24 filed against Respondent on July 16, 2024, as amended. Respondent and Paola M. Armeni, Esq.,
25 counsel for Respondent, presented Respondent’s response to the Notice.

26 Therefore, in consideration of the Jury Verdict and Respondent’s response to the Notice, by
27 unanimous vote of Commissioners Gary Vause (Chairman), Stefanie Humphrey (Vice-Chair), Karl
28 Armstrong, Esq. (Presiding Officer), Honorable Kendra Bertschy (Justice of the Peace – Reno), Patricia

1 Halstead, Esq., Joseph Sanford, and Honorable Natalie Tyrrell (Justice of the Peace – North Las
2 Vegas), and pursuant to NRS 1.4675(2)(b) and (5) and PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii):

3 **RESPONDENT’S SUSPENSION FROM THE EXERCISE OF JUDICIAL OFFICE WITHOUT**
4 **SALARY IS RESCINDED AND IMMEDIATELY REINSTATED AS OF DECEMBER 20, 2024.**

5 The Commissioners above have authorized the Chairman of the Commission to sign this Order
6 Rescinding and Reinstating Suspension of Respondent from the Exercise of Judicial Office Without
7 Salary on its behalf. The Clerk of the Commission shall promptly file a certified copy of this Order with



9 **NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S INTENT TO RESCIND AND REINSTATE SUSPENSION OF**
10 **RESPONDENT WITHOUT SALARY**

11 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE on the 13th day of December, 2024, at 12:00 p.m., the Commission
12 will hold a public hearing regarding rescinding and reinstating the suspension of Judge Michele Fiore
13 from the exercise of judicial office, without salary, pursuant to NRS 1.4675(2)(b) and Commission
14 Procedural Rule ("PRJDC") 9.6(C)(ii). The public hearing will be conducted via Simultaneous
15 Audiovisual Transmission ("S.A.T.") utilizing the Zoom virtual platform and will be available to the
16 public live via YouTube. The Zoom information will be distributed to parties at a later date, and the
17 YouTube link for public viewing will be posted on the Commission's website (<https://judicial.nv.gov/>)
18 under "Public Hearing Schedules" not less than 24 hours prior to the hearing.

19 On October 21, 2024, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Respondent from the
20 Exercise of Judicial Office Without Salary pursuant to NRS 1.4675(2)(b) and (5). Under NRS
21 1.4675(7), within 60 days after a decision by the Commission to suspend a judge, the Commission shall
22 (a) have a formal statement of charges filed against the judge; (b) rescind the suspension; or (c) enter
23 into a deferred discipline agreement with the judge pursuant to NRS 1.468.

24 Since the filing of a formal statement of charges is premature given Respondent's pending
25 sentencing date scheduled for March 10, 2025, based on the Jury Verdict against Respondent filed in
26 the United States District Court for the District of Nevada on October 3, 2024 (Case No. 2:24-cr-00155-
27 JAD_DJA-1), and a deferred discipline agreement is not justified under NRS 1.468, the Commission
28 must rescind the suspension of Respondent.

1 Pursuant to PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii), since “the circumstances justifying the Commission’s previous
2 decision to suspend the judge still exist after sixty days, the Commission may rescind and immediately
3 reinstate the suspension but must hold a public hearing pursuant to NRS 1.4675(5) unless the judge
4 waives the right to the hearing.”

5 Accordingly, the Commission provides seven (7) days’ notice of its intent to rescind and
6 reinstate Respondent’s suspension without salary and an opportunity to respond pursuant to NRS
7 1.4675(5) and PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii). You may respond in writing no later than 4:30 p.m., PST, on
8 December 6, 2024, or by attending the hearing in person with or without counsel. You may also waive
9 the hearing pursuant to NRS 1.4675(5) and PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii).
