ORDER RESCINDING AND REINSTATING SUSPENSION OF RESPONDENT FROM THE EXERCISE OF JUDICIAL OFFICE WITHOUT SALARY

On February 3, 2025, the Commission issued Respondent a Notice of Commission's Intent to Rescind and Reinstate Suspension of Respondent Without Salary ("Notice"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. In accordance with the Notice, NRS 1.4675(5) and Commission Procedural Rule ("PRJDC") 9.6(C)(ii), Respondent notified the Commission in writing on February 6, 2025, and requested the opportunity to appear at a public hearing to respond.

On February 11, 2025, a public hearing was held via Simultaneous Audiovisual Transmission ("S.A.T.") utilizing the Zoom virtual platform and was available to the public live via YouTube. Pursuant to the Jury Verdict, which was filed in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada on October 3, 2024 (Case No.: 2:24-cr-00155-JAD-DJA-1), the jury found Respondent guilty of seven (7) felony counts under the laws of the United States as set forth in the Criminal Indictment filed against Respondent on July 16, 2024, as amended. Gia Marina, Esq., counsel for Respondent, presented Respondent's response to the Notice.

Therefore, in consideration of the Jury Verdict and Respondent's response to the Notice, by unanimous vote of Commissioners Stefanie Humphrey (Chairwoman), John Krmpotic (Vice-Chair), Karl Armstrong, Esq. (Presiding Officer), Honorable Kendra Bertschy (Justice of the Peace – Reno),

Patricia Halstead, Esq., Joseph Sanford, and Honorable Barbara Schifalacqua (Justice of the Peace -Henderson), and pursuant to NRS 1.4675(2)(b) and (5) and PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii): RESPONDENT'S SUSPENSION FROM THE EXERCISE OF JUDICIAL OFFICE WITHOUT SALARY IS RESCINDED AND IMMEDIATELY REINSTATED AS OF FEBRUARY 14, 2025 The Commissioners above have authorized the Chairwoman of the Commission to sign this Order Rescinding and Reinstating Suspension of Respondent from the Exercise of Judicial Office Without Salary on its behalf. NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S INTENT TO RESCIND AND REINSTATE SUSPENSION OF RESPONDENT WITHOUT SALARY

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE on the 11th day of February, 2025, at 12:00 p.m., the Commission will hold a public hearing regarding rescinding and reinstating the suspension of Judge Michele Fiore from the exercise of judicial office, without salary, pursuant to NRS 1.4675(2)(b) and Commission Procedural Rule ("PRJDC") 9.6(C)(ii). The public hearing will be conducted via Simultaneous Audiovisual Transmission ("S.A.T.") utilizing the Zoom virtual platform and will be available to the public live via YouTube. The Zoom information will be distributed to parties at a later date, and the YouTube link for public viewing will be posted on the Commission's website (https://judicial.nv.gov/) under "Public Hearing Schedules" not less than 24 hours prior to the hearing.

On December 18, 2024, the Commission issued an Order Rescinding and Reinstating Suspension of Respondent from the Exercise of Judicial Office Without Salary pursuant to NRS 1.4675(2)(b) and PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii). Under NRS 1.4675(7), within 60 days after a decision by the Commission to suspend a judge, the Commission shall (a) have a formal statement of charges filed against the judge; (b) rescind the suspension; or (c) enter into a deferred discipline agreement with the judge pursuant to NRS 1.468.

Since the filing of a formal statement of charges is premature given Respondent's pending sentencing date scheduled for March 10, 2025, based on the Jury Verdict against Respondent filed in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada on October 3, 2024 (Case No. 2:24-cr-00155-

JAD DJA-1), and a deferred discipline agreement is not justified under NRS 1.468, the Commission 1 must rescind the suspension of Respondent. 2 Pursuant to PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii), since "the circumstances justifying the Commission's previous 3 decision to suspend the judge still exist after sixty days, the Commission may rescind and immediately 4 reinstate the suspension but must hold a public hearing pursuant to NRS 1.4675(5) unless the judge 5 waives the right to the hearing." 6 Accordingly, the Commission provides seven (7) days' notice of its intent to rescind and 7 reinstate Respondent's suspension without salary and an opportunity to respond pursuant to NRS 8 1.4675(5) and PRJDC 9.6(C)(ii). You may respond in writing no later than 4:30 p.m., PST, on February 9 7, 2025, or by attending the hearing in person with or without counsel.
