## ORDER CONTINUING HEARING

Respondent's five (5)-day disciplinary hearing before the Nevada Commission on Judicial Discipline ("Commission"), scheduled to commence on December 14, 2020, is continued until further order of the Commission.

The continuance is granted solely on the basis of the Commission's receipt of an Affidavit from Respondent's physician filed with the Commission by Respondent's counsel at 3:28 p.m. on Thursday, December 11, 2020.<sup>1</sup> The Affidavit was submitted to the Commission under seal by Respondent's counsel and served on all parties/counsel pursuant to the Commission's Order issued on Tuesday, December 8, 2020.

This case is now ready to proceed and be heard by the Commission in all respects upon further order of the Commission. All previous filing deadlines set forth in the Commission's Prehearing Order issued on September 23, 2020, remain in effect and shall not be extended or renewed upon the setting of a new hearing date by the Commission. Accordingly, no additional pre-trial motions, including motions in limine, will be considered by the Commission, except upon leave of the Commission and for good cause shown.

Counsel to the parties are further directed to comply with the Commission's Orders previously issued in this case prior to requesting the issuance of new subpoenas for the future hearing dates to be
